Role: **Collection Helper**

Hours: Flexible based on availability. Could be 2 hours a month or more.

Location: Supermarkets, stations and events across Liverpool, Southport, the Wirral or Wales.

Reports to: Freshfields Community Fundraiser

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

‘Making a difference **together** for All animals’.

Collections at supermarkets and events and shops provides a very important source of funding that helps keep Freshfields Animal Rescue rescuing. This role could be a bucket collection or bag pack, helping for a couple of hours, one day a year or a few times a month. It’s a great way to meet a wide variety of people who also love their animals and want to make a difference to their lives, and it also helps us to promote important events and fundraising opportunities.

You will learn all about the rescue before you start and have lots of support.

KEY TASKS

This is a communication focused role which involves the following aspects:

- To hold a stand out in the community, to stand with a collection bucket or to help with bag packing collections.
- To chat with the public about the rescue work that they are supporting and why it is needed so much.
- To let people know about Freshfields strong values and how we never put a healthy animal down or give up on an animal
- To let people know about the wide range of animals we care for and all the work we do out in the community too.
- To give people examples’ of animals that we have helped.
- To talk about the range of ways that people can help, from very simple things to becoming a fundraising volunteer. This may include joining our lottery, sponsoring an animal or simply joining our mailing list.

- To be a positive advocate for the important work of Freshfields Animal Rescue.

2. Able to communicate and relate to a wide range of people from diverse interests and backgrounds
3. Well -presented and willing to wear a Freshfields sash or t-shirt
